Canterbury is the largest and most location-diverse region in New Zealand, bordered to the east by an expansive and accessible coastline, to the west by the world-famous Southern Alps.

At its heart is Ōtautahi Christchurch, the country's second largest city and the main urban centre of Te Waipounamu, the beautiful South Island. Other regional destination gems include Hanmer Springs, Kaikoura, Akaroa, and the Mackenzie Country.

The region has long been a place of exploration. From early Māori explorers to the first European settlers, Canterbury is home to a people willing to shake things up and challenge the status quo. Kate Sheppard started the international women's suffrage movement from Christchurch, Ernest Rutherford began his studies at the University of Canterbury, and many heroic and modern-day Antarctic expeditions began in the port town of Lyttelton. A spirit of exploration remains strong in the Canterbury population.

Christchurch International Airport is New Zealand's second largest airport with excellent connections to domestic and international destinations.

It is located just 10 kilometres from Christchurch CBD and serves as a basecamp to kick off explorations across Canterbury and the South Island.
